## Uniform and Dress Code at Dunottar

#### Years 7-11



- Outdoor coats should be plain, navy or black, and must be longer than the blazer. Leather jackets are not allowed.
- Coats are only to be worn before school, at break times and after school and must be removed before returning to lessons.
- Hair should be neat, clean and tidy and of a natural colour. Hair that is shoulder length or longer should be worn tied back with a blue or black hair tie.
- Fringes should be above the eyebrows or held in place, off the face, with a plain black or blue hair clip or band. Short hair should be long enough so that the scalp is not visible, and we would recommend that it be no shorter than grade 3. "Skin-fades" or shaved-in designs are not acceptable.
- Boys should be clean shaven at all times.
- Earrings are permitted for pupils who may wear one plain gold or silver stud earring in the lobe of each ear, but must be removed for sport. No additional piercings are allowed.

- We understand the importance of symbolic items to some people based on religion and culture and are keen that this can be accommodated through discussion with the Head of Year.
- A watch may be worn but must be removed for PE, in the interests of safety.
- Book bags must be black or navy.
- Ties should be worn to the waist and the top button of shirts should always be done up.
- Skirts must be no more than 10cm above the knee when seated (i.e. knee length).
- No make-up or nail polish should be worn.
- Shoes must be formal black shoes. Black trainer type shoes like the ones pictured are not permitted.



 Pupils may need to wear alternative footwear for medical reasons, but, in these instances, appropriate medical documentation should be passed on to the relevant Head of Year.

## Equipment

It is useful for all pupils to have the following equipment. Please ensure that all belongings are clearly marked with your child's name.

- Casio FX83 GTPLUS scientific calculator
- A well-stocked pencil case including a pair of compasses, see-through protractor and 30cm ruler
- A small pair of headphones
- In Year 9, students are required to have a ring file for each science subject

#### Sixth Form Dress Code

To promote a business-like environment and in keeping with other independent schools, the dress code for Sixth Form pupils is smart business wear. Make up and jewellery should be minimal. Our aim is to instil an understanding of the need to dress in a manner appropriate for the school environment and to act as positive role models to the rest of the pupils in the school. You should take pride in your appearance.

#### Uniform

- Smart, tailored trouser or skirt suit or shift dress. Can include patterns such as stripes or checks. Chinos are also permitted
- Smart shirt or blouse (subtle pattern permitted)
- Jackets required for assemblies and formal occasions
- Plain fitted jumper or neat quarter zip (single colour with small logo only)
- Navy or black tights

- Earrings should be studs or small hoops
- No facial piercings unless for cultural or religious reasons
- Skirt mid-thigh length (tailored, no T-shirt/ jersey material)
- Black, navy, or brown formal leather shoes
- Tie to be worn with a shirt
- A Sixth Form tie for formal events and Mondays (details to follow in September)

### **Sportswear**

- Must always be wearing a Dunottar branded top (white or senior sports)
- Black sports leggings or trousers (minimal branding)
- Suitable footwear for sport and physical activity. No fashion trainers to be worn
- Those competing in competitive sport must wear suitable Dunottar team kit
- Dorking kit can be worn on match days
