Information regarding payments

All fees are payable strictly in advance and become due on the first day of term. Late payment of fees is subject to a late payment charge. No rebate of fees is allowed by the School for absence. There is an optional Fees Refund Scheme to provide against loss of fees through illness which parents are advised to take out.

Our preference for fee payment is termly direct debit and we offer a slightly discounted rate for using this facility. The Autumn term's payment will be debited on 1 September (or the next working day). If you wish to pay in monthly instalments by direct debit, the first payment will be debited on 1 August (or the next working day). In some circumstances, arrangements can be made to use alternative payment methods. Please email finance@dunottarschool.com if you would like to discuss this further.

The School requires a full term's notice of withdrawal in writing, on or before the first day of term, of the removal of the pupil from the School. The same notice is required for cessation of any co-curricular subject or coach travel. In the event of withdrawal without the required notice, a full term's fees will be charged in lieu.
