SCHOOL DRESS CODE: YEAR 7-11

In addition to always wearing the correct uniform, the following standards are expected at Dunottar:

- Outdoor coats should be plain, navy or black, and must be longer than the blazer. Leather or denim jackets are not allowed.
- Coats are only to be worn before school, at break times and after school and must be removed before returning to lessons.
- Hair should be neat, clean, and tidy, and of a natural colour. Hair that is shoulder-length or longer should be worn tied back with a blue or black hair tie.
- Fringes should be above the eyebrows or held in place, off the face, with a plain black or blue hair clip or band. Short hair should be long enough so that the scalp is not visible, and we would recommend that it be no shorter than grade 3. "Skin-fades" or shaved-in designs are not acceptable.
- Boys should be clean shaven at all times.
- Earrings are permitted for pupils who may wear one plain gold or silver stud earring in the lobe of each ear, but must be removed for sport. No additional piercings are allowed.
- We understand the importance of symbolic items to some people based on religion and culture and are keen that this can be accommodated through discussion with the Head of Year.
- A watch may be worn but must be removed for PE in the interests of safety.
- Book bags must be black or navy.
- Ties should be worn to the waist and the top button of shirts should always be done up and tucked in.
- Skirts must be no more than 10cm above the knee when seated (i.e. knee length).
- No make-up or nail polish should be worn.
- Shoes must be formal black shoes. Black trainer-type shoes are not permitted. Shoes should be clean and polished.
- Pupils may need to wear alternative footwear for medical reasons, but, in these instances, appropriate medical documentation should be passed on to the relevant Head of Year.

- ▶ Navy blazer with school crest*
- ▶ Dark grey trousers
- ▶ Kilt *
- ▶ Pin-stripe blue and white shirt/blouse (short or long sleeved) *
- ▶ Navy V-neck jumper *
- ▶ Navy and Royal striped tie *
- ▶ Grey socks (to be worn with trousers)
- ▶ Navy opaque tights or plain white ankle socks (not trainer style socks for Years 7-9)
- ▶ Navy or flesh-coloured tights for Years 10-11

ALL OTHER CLOTHING ITEMS

- ▶ Waterproof outdoor coat: smart plain navy or black coat - no hoodies or casual jackets
- ▶ Plain black or navy book bag
- ▶ Plain black shoes (no boots, open-toed sandals or ballet pumps)
- ▶ Navy scarf (optional)
- ▶ Navy fleece beanie (optional)
- ▶ Dark coloured ribbon or scrunchie
- ▶ House shirt (your child will be allocated to their House at the New Pupil Morning) *

MOUTHGUARDS

Pupils will need a mouthguard for rugby. Parents will need to purchase a high-grade bite and boil mouthguard, or order online using OPRO's home mould package. Alternatively, you can purchase mouthguards from sports shops, Schoolblazer (accessories), or they can be fitted by your own dentist/orthodontist. Please note it is essential that you ask for **Hi-impact** or **Pro-impact weight**. No clear or white designs are allowed.

All items of uniform and clothing marked with (*) should be purchased from Schoolblazer.com. Items without (*) can be purchased elsewhere. All items of school uniform must be clearly named. Schoolblazer do offer a naming service.

EQUIPMENT

Pupils should have a well-stocked pencil case containing the following items:

- ▶ Drawing pencils: 2H or H (technical drawing), HB (normal use), B or 2B and 4B (sketching)
- ▶ Sharpener
- ▶ Eraser (rubber not plastic)
- ▶ Colouring pencils, 12 pack (good quality - not wax crayon variety)
- ▶ Colouring felt pens, 12 pack (e.g. Berol fine or broad tip)
- ▶ Black fine-liner pen
- ▶ Black marker pen (round tip, not chisel)
- ▶ Ruler (15cm or 30cm)
- ▶ A pair of compasses
- ▶ Geometry set (protractor, set squares)
- ▶ Small scissors
- ▶ Glue stick
- ▶ Scientific calculator, Casio FX-85GTCW Black
- ▶ A small pair of headphones
- ▶ iPad stylus pen (does not have to be Apple specific)
- ▶ Food & Nutrition apron #
- ▶ Outdoor Education overalls #
